Imaging Scans to Confirm MBO

The original 3 day interval for CT scans has changed to **2 weeks**. *The original 3 day interval for CT scans to confirm MBO prior to registration has been expanded. Per Section 5.2b, scans may be done before or after admission and scans done prior may have been completed within 14 days prior to admission.*

Time Delay to Study Eligibility

Patients may still be eligible for the trial if there is a prolonged time in hospital after admission or consult if there is a medical issue that delays surgical eligibility. Examples may include need for TPN, elevated INR, or emotional issues.

Intravenous Nutrition

No matter what term is used on the chart PPN (Peripheral Parenteral Nutrition) or TPN (Total Parenteral Nutrition), for the purposes of this study, they are the same.

Follow-up calls

Patient adherence to the weekly follow-up calls has been low for some patients. When offering the study to potential patients, remind them that the weekly follow-up calls from their study site will only take a few minutes and the most important information for those calls is whether they were in the hospital recently.
