## How to fill in your site's contact information and print the S1316 brochure.

To fill in the contact information for your site and print the brochure, please follow the instructions below:

1. Open the brochure in Adobe Reader
2. Click on the box under the text, "If you have questions or would like to be part of this study, contact the research staff at:"
3. Enter the contact information.
4. If desired, you can highlight/select the text and choose to make text bold, underlined or italic by using a right click of your mouse and choosing the options from the "Text Style" menu.  
*\*Note - Adobe Reader will allow you save the contact information to the brochure. Use the "File>Save As" command to save the contact information in the brochure.*
5. To print the brochure, click on the printer icon in the toolbar or choose the "File>Print" command. Many printers have a "Print on both sides" option. If you are using this option, be sure to select the option to flip the document "over" instead of "up". Or, if your option is to flip the brochure on the "long-edge" or the "short-edge", be sure to select the option that will flip it on the "short-edge".
